All classes generally run 4 weeks consecutively (weather/holiday permitting.) Each class cost \$125. Everything is included to complete 4-8 pieces. Instruction, tools, clay & glazing. No other fees are associated with classes. \*\*Bonus available for those students that wish to continue: Sign up for a future class and get a free private glazing lesson (approx. 1- 2 hrs & only available to first time or new students that sign up for a second class) *All pieces from children under 16 or those not wishing to continue at the studio will be glazed by the instructor and will be available 2-3 weeks later.* A free 1 day pass into the studio is available to anyone with experience in glazing or who had a previous private glazing lesson. \*\*summer kid's clay experiences excluded

Remember space is limited. Please contact me if you want to be assured of a space! I can also personalize to your group needs as well!

If you and 3-5 of your friends or family are interested in taking a class together, I will work on a class to suit your individual wants/needs (all classes are limited to 6.) Not crazy about working in a group? I also do private/semi private lessons that I can tailor to your specific needs.
